<b>Cercis canadensis "Forest Pansy"</b>	
<b>Cercis occidentalis "Alba"</b>	Rare Western "White" Bud, native, 15 feet
<b>Cercis occidentalis</b>	Western Red Bud, native, 15 feet
<b>Cornus capitata</b>	Himalayan Dogwood, evergreen, 30 feet
<b>Cornus controversa "Variegata"</b>	Giant Dogwood, green foliage edged in white
<b>Cornus florida "Cherokee Brave"</b>	New growth burgundy red, turning dark rich green with age
<b>Cornus florida "Cherokee Princess"</b>	Prolific white bracts
<b>Cornus florida "Cherokee Sunset"</b>	Variegated leaf (green w yellow margin), deep pink bracts
<b>Cornus florida "Pink Flame"</b>	Variegated leaf (green, yellow, pink), medium pink bracts
<b>Cornus kousa</b>	Seedling, Multi
<b>Cornus kousa "Milky Way"</b>	Long lasting blooms
<b>Cornus kousa "Miss Satomi"</b>	Red bloom
<b>Cornus kousa "Prophet"</b>	Similar to 'Milky Way'
<b>Cornus kousa "Samzam"</b>	Variegated leaf, creamy white edge w/ undulating margin
<b>Cornus kousa "Schmred" (Heartthrob)</b>	Rare, deep red bloom
<b>Cornus kousa "Wolf Eye"</b>	Variegated leaf (green with white border), white blooms
<b>Cornus nuttallii</b>	
<b>Cornus walteri</b>	Prized for bark and 3in white flower clusters in June
<b>Cornus kousa x capitata "Porlock"</b>	Semi evergreen, late bloomer
<b>Cornus x rutban "Aurora"</b>	Vigorous, white bracts
<b>Cornus x rutcan "Constellation"</b>	Vigorous, white bracts
<b>Cornus x rutdan "Celestial"</b>	Bracts first deep cut form, light greenish tinge, become fully white
<b>Cornus x rutgan "Stellar Pink"</b>	Vigorous, soft pink bracts
<b>Cornus x KN4-43 "Starlight"</b>	Vigorous, oversize white blooms
<b>Cornus x KN30-8 "Venus"</b>	Vigorous, oversize white blooms

<b>Lagerstroemia indica "Tonto"</b>	Multi, to 10 ft, fuchsia, maroon in fall
<b>Lagerstroemia indica "Prairie Lace"</b>	Multi, to 6 ft, pink banded in white, red in fall
<b>Lagerstroemia indica "Acoma"</b>	Multi, to 12 ft, white, red/purple in fall
<b>Lagerstroemia indica "Tuscarora"</b>	Multi, to 20+ ft, dark coral pink, red/orange in fall
<b>Malus "Thunderchild"</b>	Deep purple foliage, pink flowers
<b>Malus sargentii "Roselow"</b>	True apple shrub, profuse wt. flowers, dark red fruit, 6 feet
<b>Olea europaea "Hills of Santa Cruz"</b>	Fruitless olive, multi
<b>Oxydendrum arboreum</b>	Sourwood
<b>Paeonia (Various)</b>	Herbaceous Peony, 12 to 15 different hybrids
<b>Paeonia suffruticosa</b>	Tree Peony
<b>Paulownia tomentosa</b>	Princess Tree
<b>Picea pungens glauca "Fat Albert"</b>	Semi-dwarf Colorado Blue Spruce
<b>Persimmon "Fuyu" (Jiro)</b>	
<b>Pomegranate "Angel Red"</b>	New Release, similar to Wonderful, fruit ripens weeks earlier
<b>Pomegranate "Wonderful"</b>	Best known variety, orange-red flowers, burnished red fruit

<b>Sambucus "Black Lace"</b>	
<b>Spirea x japonica "Dakota Goldcharm"</b>	Dwarf, gold leaf, bright pink summer flower clusters
<b>Spirea x japonica "Flaming Mound"</b>	Low spreading form, w/ gold and red foliage
<b>Spirea x "Renaissance"</b>	Improved "Vanhouttei"
<b>Syringa reticulata "Mandshurica"</b>	Manchurian Tree Lilac, white, 12 feet
<b>Syringa x hyacinthiflora "Angel White"</b>	Descanso hybrid, white
<b>Syringa x hyacinthiflora "Dark Night"</b>	Descanso hybrid, darkest of the Descanso
<b>Syringa x hyacinthiflora "Lavender Lady"</b>	Descanso hybrid, most popular
<b>Syringa x hyacinthiflora "Sylvan Beauty"</b>	Descanso hybrid, deep purple
<b>Syringa x persica "Tinker Belle"</b>	"Tinkerbelle" wine red opens to pink
<b>Syringa vulgaris "Sensation"</b>	Stunning wine red, edged white
